All matters are deemed submitted as of _____. If any dispositive motion or response brief is filed before the above listed deadline, the parties shall comply with Loc.R. 7.14(C) for the deadlines to file their response or reply brief.

Agreed and Proposed Jury Instructions, Interrogatories, Motions in Limine, Witness Lists, Exhibit Lists, Transcripts of Deposition Testimony to be presented at trial (with objections marked), Stipulations and Trial Briefs shall be filed fourteen (14) days prior to trial. Plaintiff's counsel shall email agreed upon jury instructions to callahanjatty@cpcourt.summitoh.net. Separate instructions, only on issues where agreement is not possible, shall be emailed by the proposing party.

FINAL PRETRIAL DATE: _____

All clients must be present at the final pretrial hearing with trial counsel of record. If an insurance company is involved, a representative with full settlement authority shall attend.

TRIAL WILL PROCEED UNTIL AT LEAST 5:00 P.M. EACH DAY. COUNSEL SHALL BE PREPARED TO PRESENT TESTIMONY UNTIL 5:00 P.M. EACH DAY OF TRIAL UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTIFIED BY THE COURT.

FURTHER, PLEASE NOTE THAT THE COURT'S CRIMINAL CALL DAY IS ON WEDNESDAY. ACCORDINGLY, TRIAL WILL NOT GO FORWARD ON WEDNESDAY MORNING. THE COURT WILL DISCUSS THE SCHEDULE FOR WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON WITH COUNSEL AT THE FINAL PRETRIAL.

Counsel and/or parties shall fully comply with this Order, irrespective of the status of any settlement negotiations or any other considerations.

Failure to comply with any orders of this Court may result in sanctions being imposed, including adverse judgment for failure to prosecute or defend.
